Government Service Counselling 2021

As you are aware that COVID 19 pandemic has gripped the nation and the cases are increasing day by day. The Government of Karnataka is doing its best in containing the spread by active contact tracing, testing and adequate treatment.

As per the instructions received from the Government, all candidates selecting Government seats who have successfully completed and passed in their final examination MD/MS/Diploma November 2020 have to serve the Government under the "Karnataka Conduct of Entrance Test for Selection and Admission to Post Graduate Medical and Dental Degree and Diploma Courses (Amendment) Rules 2006".

Whereas the Honorable Supreme Court has reiterated that students should undergo compulsory Government Service.

In exercise of powers vested in me under clauses (f), (h), (j) and (l) of section 24 of the Disaster Management Act 2005 vide order of the Government number RD 158 TNR 2020 and the Epidemic diseases act, 1897, I hereby order that all the postgraduate who graduated from the State of Karnataka after September 2020 shall come and register for the Government service.

The following are the steps which will be followed for allotment of Government Service for Post graduates have been admitted after July 2015 passed in November 2020.

- i. The link for option / priority entry for Government Service Counseling shall be published on website.
- ii. The online counseling shall be merit based and the compiled requirement shall be provided by Medical Education and Health department.
- iii. A merit list of candidates based on their Qualifying final post graduate examination and be considered for allotment based on the priority entry by the candidate.
- iv. Process of online options entry and allotment:

- 1) The candidate may select the department Medical Education/Institute of his choice among the displayed options at time of entry of options.
- 2) The candidate will have the choice to add or remove priority to which he is interested in, irrespective of the vacancy in the order of priority.
- 3) The order of priority can also be re arranged or deleted until the last date and time. After the last date there is no scope to enter or reorder or delete options.
- 4) Candidates are advised to enter any number of options to avoid any disappointment of being posted Suo moto (from the existing vacancies).
- 5) After the compilation of all the priorities and based on the merit list, the candidate's allotment order shall be published
- 6) Once allotment process is complete there is no scope for any change of allotment or transfer.
- 7) The allotment logic/module/system follows the Merit of the candidate along with the entered options and priorities given by the candidate.

For example:

If he/she entered Options with the priorities as given below, then the system would check the vacancy availability as per the merit & priorities and allot the postings, if it is available.

For Eg: Subject Medicine

Priority 1- KIMS

Priority 2 – MMCRI

Priority 3 - VIMS

Priority 4 - BMCRI

Scenario 1 (Higher merit): the system would check the vacancy for the above four options one by one starting from the priority No. 1 to 4 in order and would allot based on the availability. Assume that the candidate is having required merit to avail any vacancy of the above four priorities including the Priority no. 3 or 4. The system would allot only against option/priority No. 01 as vacancy is available as per his merit. This candidate will be allotted Priority 1. He will not be considered for the remaining priorities.

Scenario 2 (Medium merit): the system would check the vacancy for the above four options one by one starting from the priority No. 1 to 4 in order and would allot based on the availability. Assume that the candidate is having medium merit. If the higher merit candidate has been allotted priority 1 and there are no further vacancies in that institute then the system would allot only against option/priority No. 02

as vacancy is available. This candidate will be allotted Priority 2. He will not be considered for the remaining priorities.

i. Date of Notification : 12thApril 2021
ii. Vacancy : 12thApril 2021

iii. Option Entry : 15th– 16thApril 2021

iv. Processing of results & verification

: 17thApril 2021

v. Announcing of results : 18th April 2021 after 16:00 hrs

vi. Date of Start of Government service: 19th- 22ndApril 2021

Note:

Candidates who have selected Government Seats and do not exercise options/Priorities shall be posted based on the requirements and shall lose claim for posting as per merit.

As per Rule 15(7) candidates who fail to do Government service shall be liable to pay a penalty of Rs 50,00,000/- in case of Degree and Rs 25,00,000/- in case of diploma.

Candidates who do not participate or exercise options in the process or report to the posted location shall be liable for action as per Government directions.

The allotment will be on first come first serve cum merit basis. They shall lose the right to merit for allotment if they fail to register. Hence, all candidates are directed to compulsorily register, failing which suitable action will be initiated.
